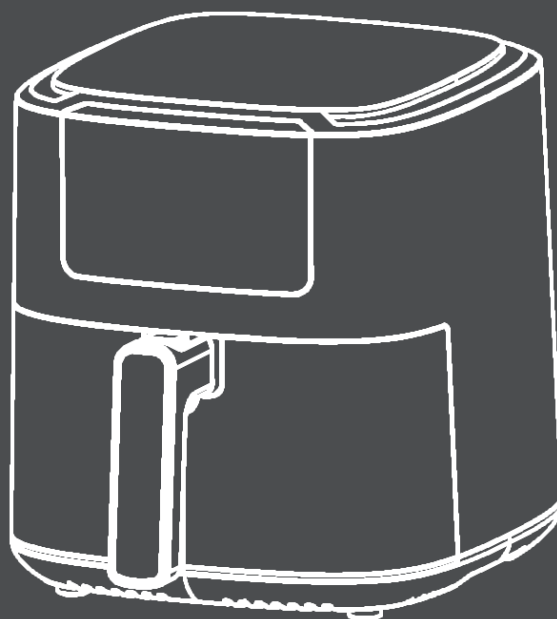

1. This Air Fryer can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
2. Keep the appliance and its power cord out of reach of children. DO NOT allow the appliance to be used by unsupervised children. Close supervision is necessary when used near children. To eliminate a choking hazard for young children, remove and discard the protective cover fitted on the power plug of this appliance.
3. To eliminate a choking hazard for young children, remove and discard the protective cover fitted on the power plug of this appliance.
4. Children should not play with the appliance.
5. NEVER use an power supply socket below counter.
6. NEVER connect this appliance to an external timer switch or separate remote-control system.
7. DO NOT use an additional extension cord. The power cord with the machine is long enough to use without posing any danger for children to pull the cord and hurt themselves.

12. Before placing removable cooking insert into the main unit, ensure pan and unit are clean and dry by wiping with a soft cloth.
13. This appliance is for household use only. DO NOT use this appliance for anything other than its intended use. DO NOT use in moving vehicles or boats. DO NOT use outdoors. Misuse may cause injury or damage to the machine.
14. Intended for worktop use only. Ensure the surface is level, clean and dry. DO NOT move the appliance when in use.
15. DO NOT place the appliance near the edge of a worktop/or within reach of children during operation.
16. DO NOT use accessory attachments not recommended or sold by Hyundai Power Products.
17. When using this appliance, provide adequate space above and on all sides for air circulation.
18. ALWAYS ensure drawer is properly closed before operating.
19. DO NOT use the appliance without the removable cooking insert installed.
20. DO NOT use this appliance for deep-frying.
21. Only ever use inserts and accessories which are specifically designed to be used with Air Fryers.

21. DO NOT place the appliance on hot surfaces, near a hob burner or in an oven.
22. Prevent food contact with heating elements. DO NOT overfill when cooking. Overfilling may cause personal injury or property damage or affect the safe use of the appliance.
23. Socket voltages can vary, affecting the performance of your product. To prevent possible illness, use a thermometer to check that your food is cooked to the temperatures recommended.
24. Should the unit emit black smoke, unplug immediately. Wait for smoking to stop before removing any cooking accessories.
25. DO NOT touch hot surfaces. Appliance surfaces are hot during and after operation. To prevent burns or personal injury, ALWAYS use suitable utensils, protective heat pads and insulated cooking gloves and use available handles.
26. Extreme caution must be used when the appliance contains hot food. Improper use may result in personal injury.
27. Spilled food can cause serious burns. Keep appliance and cord away from children. DO NOT let cord hang over edges of tables or counters or touch hot surfaces.
28. The pan and crisper plate become extremely hot during the cooking process. Avoid physical contact while removing the pan or plate from the appliance. ALWAYS place pan or plate on a heat-resistant surface after removing. DO NOT touch accessories during or immediately after cooking.
29. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children.
30. To disconnect, turn off any control to OFF, then unplug from socket when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before cleaning, disassembly, putting in or taking off parts and storage.

Electrical Safety - Grounding

IMPORTANT: This appliance must be grounded. It is equipped with a cord that includes a grounding wire and a grounding plug. The plug must be inserted into a properly installed and grounded wall outlet.

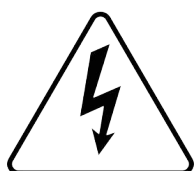

The HYAF5001DB is a 1500W Air Fryer with 5L of capacity from HYUNDAI.

The machine is manufactured according to the latest safety requirements. Every precaution is only effective when it is followed exactly.

Intended Use

This appliance is designed to heat, cook or “Air Fry” food. ALWAYS cook food according to the manufacturer's recommended instructions. In the absense of these recommendations, we have supplied some general guidelines in further in the manual.

This machine is not suitable for environments with an ambient temperature in excess of 32°C

Cooking Accessories

If you wish to use additional Air Frying specific accessories such as tray and inserts, they MUST be specifically designed for Air-Frying. any use of unsuitable accessories will be improper use and damage the machine and/or user.

User Types

This machine is intended for use by consumers, i.e. non professional operators. The machine is intended for “DIY” and domestic use only.

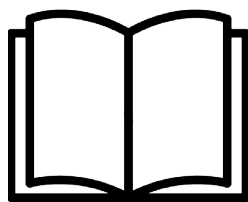
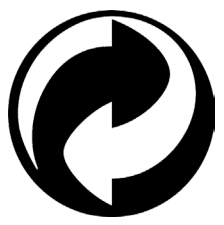

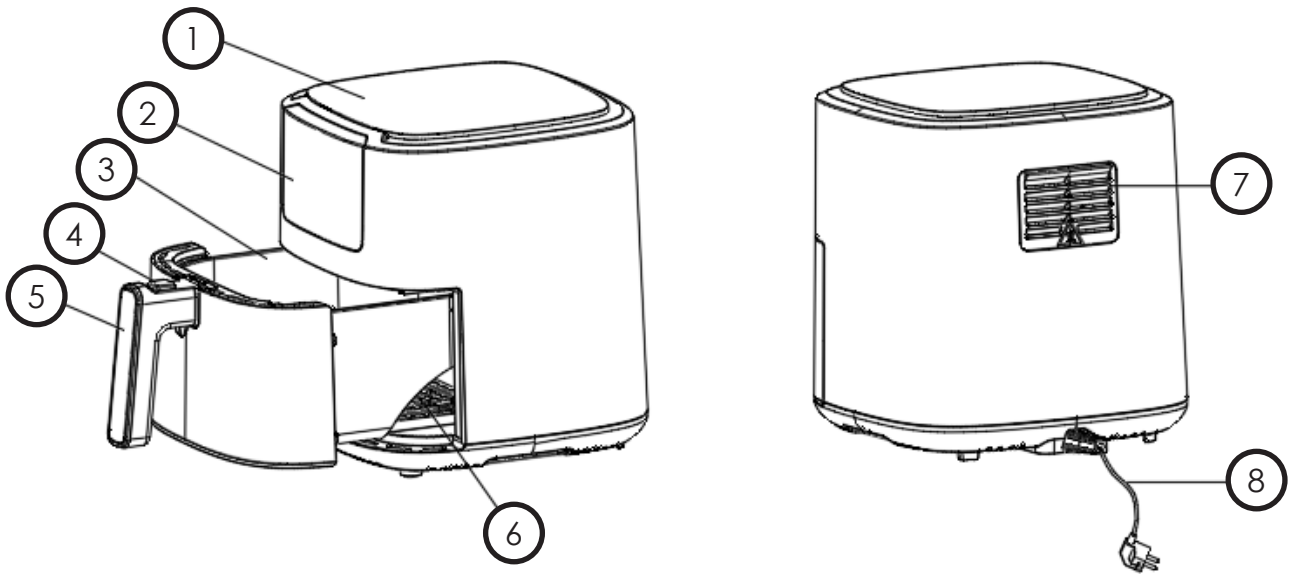

Before First Use

⚠ IMPORTANT: Before using your new Air Fryer for the first time, it is important you read through the entirety of this instruction manual and adhere to the following steps:

1. Ensure all packing materials are removed from inside the machine.
2. **WARNING!** Inspect the inside for any damage, such as a misaligned or bent door, damaged door seals or sealing surfaces, broken or loose hinges and latches, or dents inside the cavity or on the drawer. If any damage is found, do not use the oven and contact qualified service personnel.
3. Place the Air Fryer on a flat, stable surface that can support both its weight and the heaviest food it may hold.
4. Avoid placing the Air Fryer near sources of heat, moisture, high humidity, or combustible materials.
5. To ensure proper operation, allow adequate airflow around the Air Fryer. Maintain at least 20 cm of space above, 10 cm at the back, and 5 cm on both sides. Do not block or cover any of the appliance's openings. Do not remove the feet.
6. Ensure the power cord is intact and does not run under the oven or over hot or sharp surfaces.
7. The power socket should remain easily accessible for quick unplugging in case of an emergency.
8. Do not use the Air Fryer outdoors.

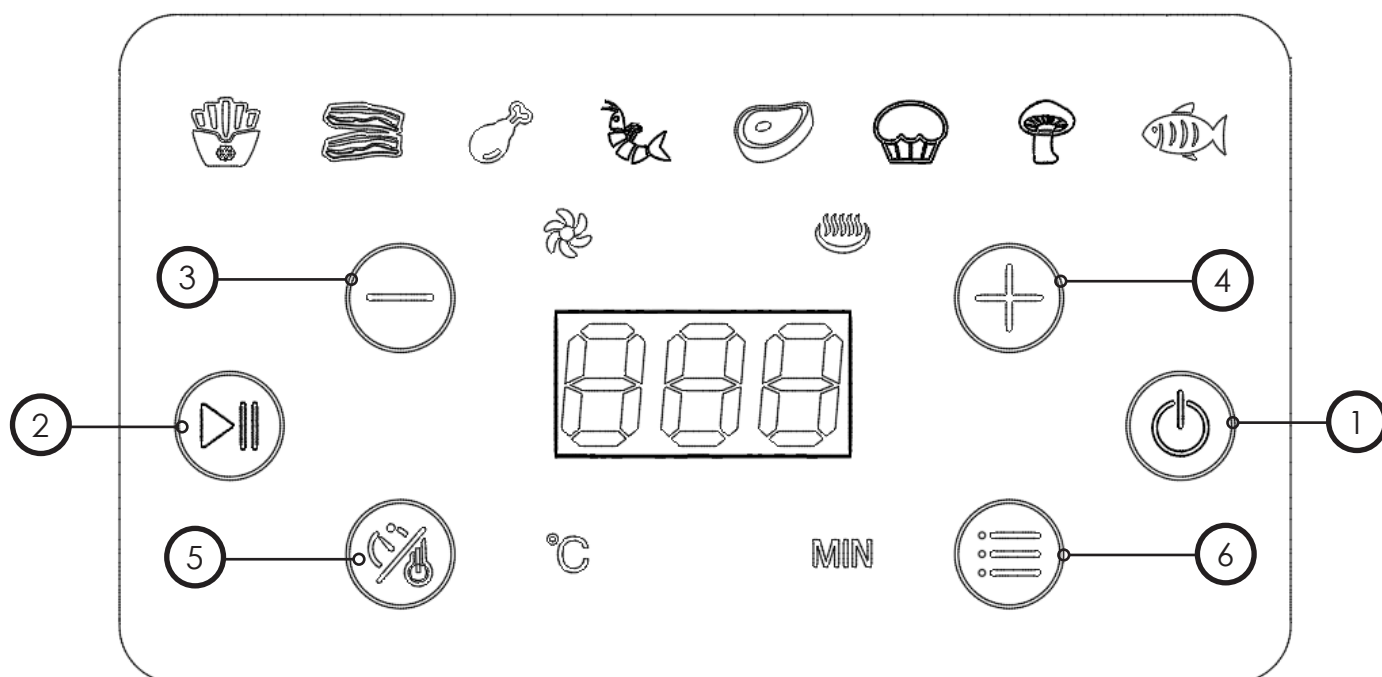

1 - Power Button - this is used to turn the machine on and off

2 - Start & Pause Button - this is used during cooking to stop and start the cooking.

3 & 4 - Plus and Minus Controls - These are to increase/decrease the temperature and the time required.

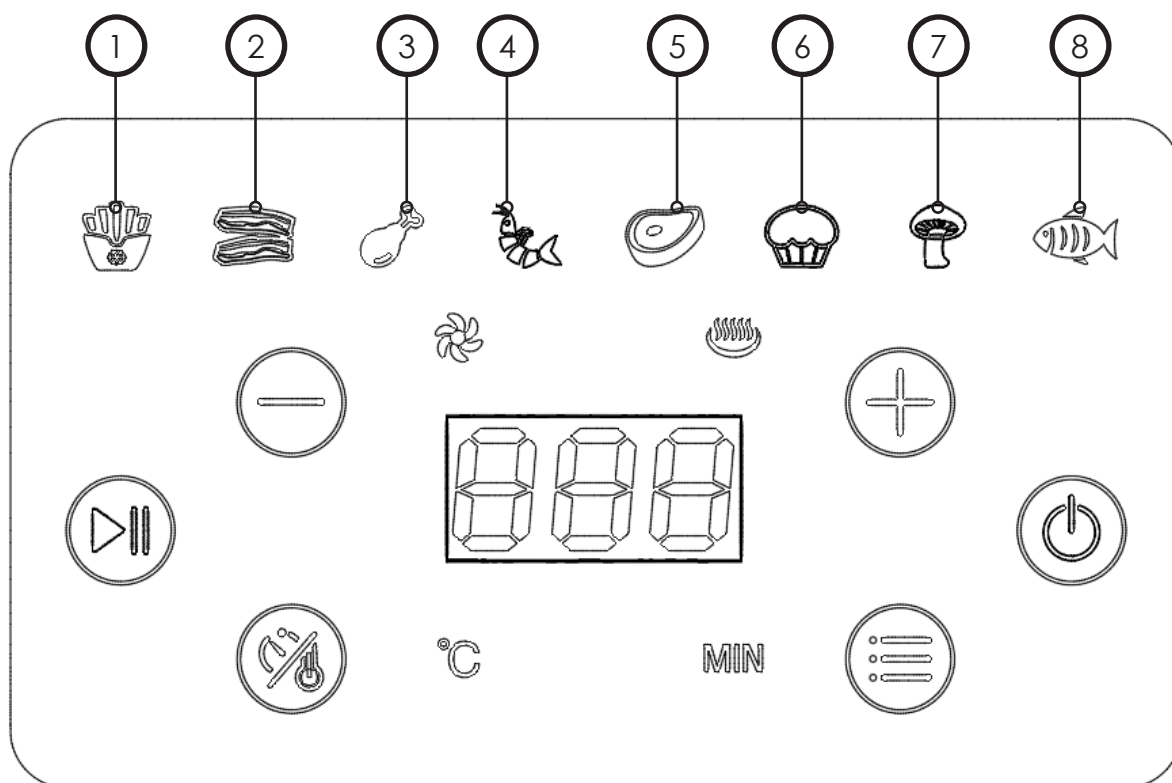
5 - Time/Temperature Toggle button - This is used to cycle the display between the current cooking temp or the remaining time.

6 - Preset Setting Button - Use this to select one of the preset settings. Cycle through them until the the desired setting is selected.

Suggested Air Fryer Settings

! IMPORTANT : Please ensure food coming from the Air Fryer is always fully cooked through and are steaming hot throughout the item.

The table below will help you to select the basic settings for the ingredients.

Note: Keep in mind that these settings are indications. As ingredients differ in origin, size, shape as well as brand, we cannot guarantee the best setting for your ingredients. Because the Rapid Air technology instantly reheats the air inside the appliance instantly. Pulling the drawer briefly out of the appliance during air frying barely disturbs the process.

Tips

- Smaller ingredients usually require a slightly shorter preparation time than larger ingredients.
- A larger amount of ingredients only requires a slightly longer preparation time, a smaller amount of ingredients only requires a slightly shorter preparation time.
- Shaking smaller ingredients halfway through the preparation time optimizes the end result and can help prevent unevenly fried ingredients.
- Add some oil to fresh potatoes for a crispy result. Fry your ingredients in the Hot-air fryer within a few minutes after you added the oil.
- Snacks that can be prepared in a oven can also be prepared in the Hot-air fryer
- The optimal amount for preparing crispy fries is 500 grams.
- Use pre-made dough to prepare filled snacks quickly and easily. Pre-made dough also requires a shorter preparation time than home-made dough.
- Place a baking tin or oven dish in the Hot-air fryer basket if you want to bake a cake or quiche or if you want to fry fragile ingredients or filled ingredients
- You can also use the Hot-air fryer to reheat ingredients. To reheat ingredients, set the temperature to 150°C for up to 10 minutes.

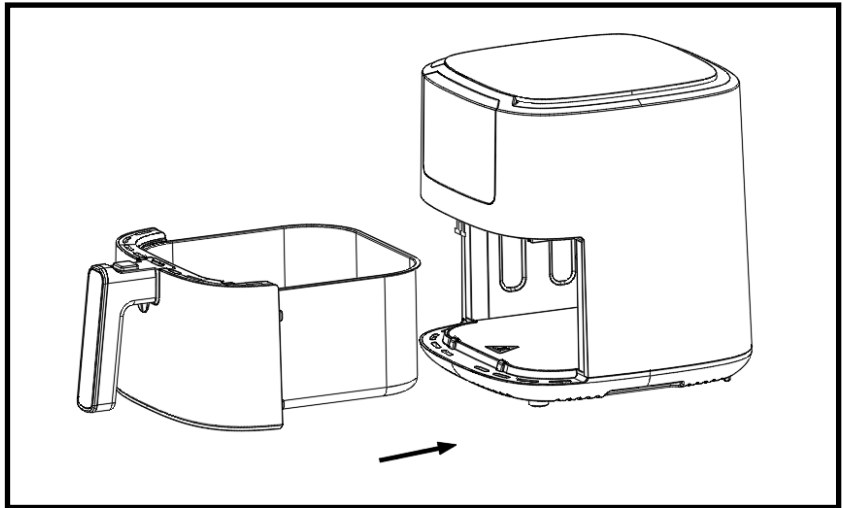
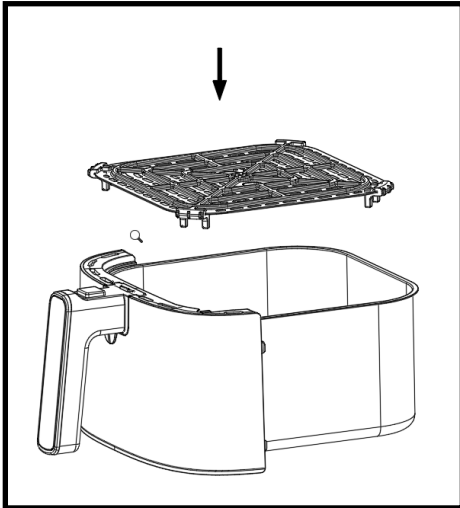
Machine Setup

Assemble Air Fryer

Place the crisping insert into the bottom of the Air Fryer Drawer. This **MUST** always be installed in the machine when operating.

Then slide the drawer into the body of the Air Fryer as shown below.

The machine can now be plugged in and used. When connecting to a power source always ensure the switch is off.



Operation

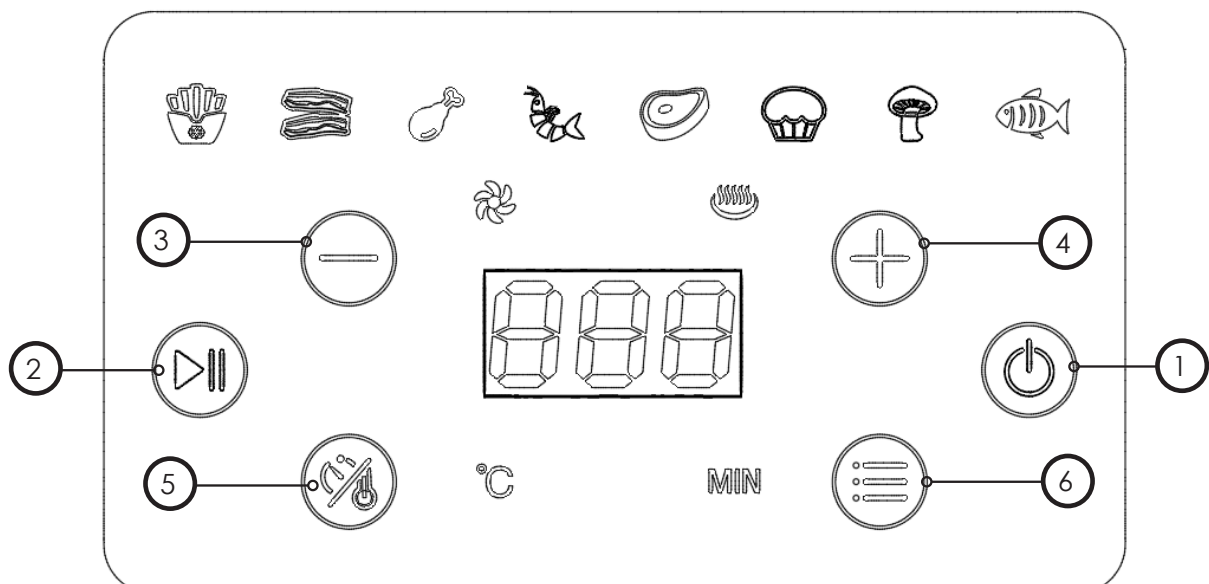
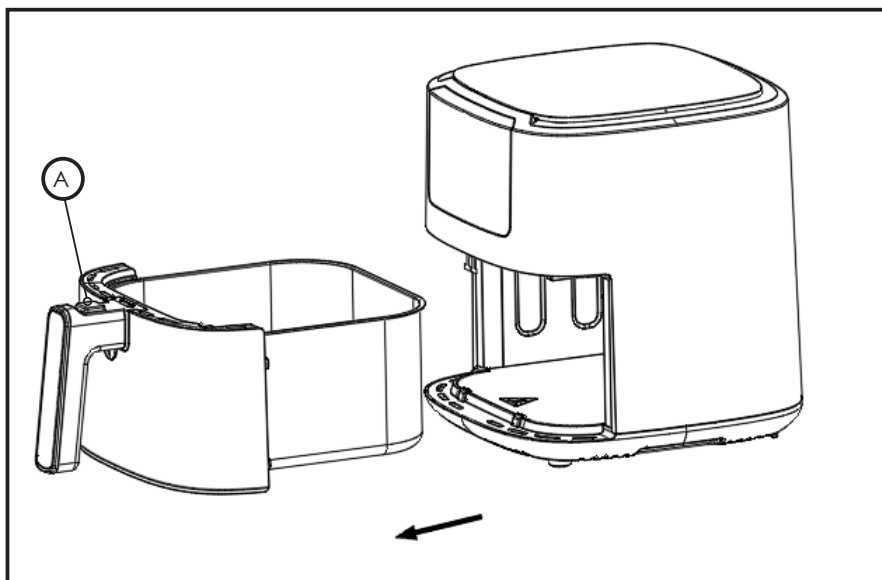
Machine Operation

After your Air Fryer Crisping tray is inserted and machine is plugged in, you're now ready.

1. Press the drawer release button (A) and pull the drawer out of the main body of the machine. Now put the food you wish to cook in the drawer on the Crisping Insert. Replace the drawer into the machine.
2. Turn the machine on by Pressing the Power Button (1)
3. Select your desired cooking settings, whether that is using the presets (button 6) or making a manual selection using buttons 3, 4 & 5.
4. Press the Start button (2). The machine will now start cooking the food within the drawer.

To pause the machine during a cooking cycle press the Start/Pause button (2).

When the machine has finished cooking, it will turn off, but if your food is cooked before the timer finishes, just hold the Power Button (1) for 2 seconds to turn off.



Maintenance & Care

Cleaning

⚠ WARNING : Always ensure the machine is cool to the touch before you start any cleaning

⚠ WARNING : NEVER fill the drawer with liquids and power up the machine. This will cause damage to both the operator and the machine.

The drawer and the Crisping Insert are using a non-stick coating. Do not use metal kitchen utensils or abrasive cleaning materials to clean them, as this may damage the non-stick coating.

1. Remove the mains plug from the wall socket and let the appliance cool down.

Note: Remove the drawer to let the Hot-air fryer cool down more quickly.

2. Wipe the outside of the appliance with a moist cloth. You can use degreasing liquid to remove any remaining dirt.

Tip: If dirt is stuck to the Removable Crisping Insert or the bottom of the pan, fill the pan with hot water with some washing-up liquid. Put the Removable Crisping Insert in the pan and let the pan and the Removable Crisping Insert soak for approximately 10 minutes.

3. Clean the inside of the appliance with hot water and non-abrasive sponge.
4. Clean the heating element with a cleaning brush to remove any food residues.

Note: The Drawer, Drawer handle, release button and crisping insert are dishwasher-proof

Storage

Unplug your machine and allow to cool completely.

Store your machine in any cool dry environment, and always ensure it's clean when it's put into storage. This will mean no food residue will go bad during storage, and it will be ready to use when needed.

Maintenance & Care

Trouleshooting

Problem	Possible cause	Solution
The Hot-air fryer does not work	The appliance is not plugged in.	Put the mains plug in polarized outlet.
The ingredients fried with the air fryer are not done.	The amount of ingredients in the Removable Crisping Insert is too big.	Put smaller batches of ingredients in the Removable Crisping Insert. Smaller batches are fried more evenly.
	The set temperature is too low.	Increase cooking temperature (see section 'settings' in chapter 'Using the appliance').
	The preparation time is too short.	Increase cooking time (see section 'Settings' in chapter 'Using the appliance').
The ingredients are fried unevenly in the air fryer.	Certain types of ingredients need to be shaken halfway through the preparation time.	Ingredients that lie on top of or across each other (e.g. fries) need to be shaken halfway through the preparation time. See section 'Settings' in chapter 'Using the appliance'.
Fried snacks are not crispy when they come out of the air fryer.	You used a type of snacks meant to be prepared in a traditional deep fryer.	Use oven snacks or lightly brush some oil onto the snacks for a crispier result.
	The Removable Crisping Insert is not placed in the pan correctly.	Push the Removable Crisping Insert down into the pan until you hear a click.
White smoke comes out of the appliance.	You are preparing greasy ingredients.	When you fry greasy ingredients in the air fryer, a large amount of oil will leak into the pan. The oil produces white smoke and the pan may heat up more than usual. This does not affect the appliance or the end result.
	The pan still contains grease residues from previous use.	White smoke is caused by grease heating up in the pan. make sure you clean the pan properly after each use.
Fresh fries are fried unevenly in the air fryer.	You did not use the right potato type.	Use fresh potatoes and make sure they stay firm during cooking.
	You did not rinse the potato sticks properly before you fried them.	
	Rinse the potato sticks properly to remove starch from the outside of the sticks.	
Fresh fries are not crispy when they come out of the air fryer.	The crispiness of the fries depends on the amount of oil and water in the fries.	Make sure you dry the potato sticks properly before you add the oil.
		Cut the potato sticks smaller for a crispier result.
		Add slightly more oil for a crispier result.
